My career began in graphic design after graduating from K-State in 1995. Training staff, art direction and project management have been common throughout my career. Initially I worked primarily on print material and branding.

In 2006 my career shifted entirely to web design. Programming and coding consumed more and more of my work and currently all I do is development (eg: node and front-end js frameworks).

Presently I am fully employed as a full stack web developer working primarily in javascript front-end frameworks with node.js applications connecting to various data sources. I work in teams with other developers employing Scrum / Agile processes.
